5. Business Arising from Prior Meeting.

- a. SHOREWAY DEVELOPMENT. After further discussions and exchanges with the RDC and the owners of Shoreway Development Incorporated, the administration advises the municipality to move forward with the \$1.8M CHIF application that has been approved by the province, and the related Developer's Agreement.

6. New Business.

- a. STATUS CHANGE OF BONAR LAW COMMON HERITAGE SITE. On Tuesday, March 18, related to the announcement of the provincial budget, Anne Hamilton of the Department of Tourism, Heritage and Culture contacted the office to tell us that the Bonar Law Heritage Site would not receive the \$55,000 operating grant for the 2026-2027 fiscal year, and further, that the province intended to close the park.

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- b. TOP-UP FUNDING. Luc Theriault, the CCBF administrator for DELG (GNB), recently advised that we have an unspent balance of **\$56,992.78** from the 2023-2024 revised CCBF funding, issued on March 13, 2023, often called “top-up” funding. Our original allocation was **\$62,658.00**. To date, we have only claimed **\$5665.00** for playground equipment in Bass River Hall.

To claim the funding, we submitted an application in September 2023 that named two projects. The first was the aforementioned playground equipment project. The second was “Various Municipal Road Upgrades.”

Luc Theriault advised that we can submit a new application with new projects, that we are not bound to the 2023 application. In addition, we would receive the funding soon after we submitted qualified claims (it’s not a semi-annual payment like regular CCBF).

Given our recent loss of \$55,000 in funding for BLC, the administration advises that we update our top-up application to include eligible projects that were budgeted in 2026, which mitigates the risk of deficit. We could also use this funding for a project that was not budgeted but needs to be addressed, the roof of the Lion’s Club, which is in rough shape and may lead to a more expensive repair this year if left unaddressed. A summary of these spends is as follows, noting that the subtotal exceeds the funding (we just claim part of one of them).

Project	Value
Lion’s Club Roof	\$25,000
Beersville Station Roof	\$30,000
Rexton Commercial Washer/Dryer	\$20,000
Subtotal	\$75,000

While a new application does not require a motion of council, the administration requests a motion of council to approve the submission of a new application as presented.

Note: The Capital Renewal Plan we recently passed contains funding for municipal signage, office restoration (mini split), and the refrigeration plant motor. It does not contain the items listed above.

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- c. PURCHASE OF COMMERCIAL WASHER/DRYER FOR REXTON FIRE DEPARTMENT. The municipality has received two quotes to purchase a commercial washer/dryer for the Rexton Fire Department, which was budgeted for \$18,000 in the 2026 general operating budget. The administration recommends the purchase from the low bidder, Safety Source, at a cost of \$21,500 (not including HST).
