A few weeks ago, after a meeting with Mayor Beers and other members of Council, I accepted their offer to become the next CAO of Five Rivers, starting in December.

For the past three years, I have been the CAO in Hartland, New Brunswick, home of the world's longest covered bridge, a rural community much like Five Rivers. Before that, I had worked 25 years in the telecom sector for several companies, including Nortel and Xplornet.
